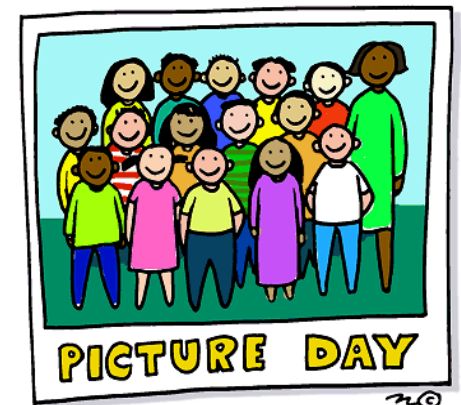
We will also start working on history as well starting with Rome. They will have some reading to do, questions to answer and worksheets to complete.
