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SBAC TESTING

For the next four weeks, your child will be state testing in their AB class or their math class. Next week will be their language test, which consist of 44-50 questions. They will not do it in one sitting. They will be answering 9-12 questions a day so that they can take their time (I am not sure how math will be administering the test). If they are absent, then towards the end of the week, they will have to finish what they missed.

It's important that they don't have any appointments during this time. Any student who is present for the whole class period during testing in my room will be eligible for a treat.

Smart watches and phones will be stored in their backpacks and put against a wall. Any talking during testing will result in automatic after school detention.

We will have results by the end of the school year. Because this is a huge test, your child could boost their grade up. If they score a 4 and don't have any late assignments, their grade could go up to an A. If they score a 3, it could go up to a B.

It's very important that your child gets plenty of rest and takes their time on the test.
