History

Illnesses

Have your child follow the following tips to prevent them from catching any illnesses. I've already talked to them about sharing food and drinks.

- *Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
- *Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands, especially after using a computer.
- *Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- *Stay home when you are sick (this is true for employees and students).
- *Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash.
- *Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.

In Clovis Unified our custodial teams clean classrooms and disinfect high contact areas (like bathrooms and doorknobs) daily. They are also disinfecting desks twice a week.
